

Weave Care Guide

Washing and drying step by step

- Hair must be brushed before washing to remove any tangles
- When washing your hair your head must be tilted backwards under a shower and gentle movements must be used, the water temperature should not be too hot as this could damage the hair extensions.
- Shampoo must be smoothed on to and rinsed through the hair.
- Conditioner must be applied to the mid lengths and ends. This can be left on for up to 5 minutes as a treatment.
- Rinse the hair thoroughly as products left behind the weave or weft can cause irritation.
- The hair must be squeezed gently with a towel to remove excess moisture.
- Leave in conditioner should be applied to the mid lengths and ends of the hair and a wide tooth comb should be used to detangle the extensions gently, working up wards starting at the end of the hair.
- Hair should be blow dried on a cool setting with air flow pointing downward.
- Once the extensions are completely dry apply a small amount of serum or hair oil to the ends of the hair extensions and use your loop brush to brush through.

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
